

Helpful Hints for Public Speaking

You must KNOW your audience before you can ENGAGE them.

You have one chance for a first impression.

Preparation will improve your chance.

◆ DURING PRESENTATION:

- Your opening will determine the audience connection.
 - ✓ In a 10-minute speech, your first 30-60 seconds dictates how much more will be heard.
 - ✓ You must have an opening hook line and engaging thought.
 - Once you lose your listener it is hard to regain them.
- Don't sweat the small stuff.
 - \checkmark Some specifics are too specific and not relevant.
 - EXP: 99.9% of the time it doesn't matter if the event was a Tuesday or Friday.
- Body gestures matter. Stay under control.
 - ✓ Too many hand gestures distract.
 - ✓ Pacing distracts.
- Voice rhythm needs to change.
 - ✓ Use "your" voice.
 - ✓ Speak slowly enough to be heard and quickly enough to keep your listener's attention.
- Volume- Speak to the back of the room.
 - \checkmark People will not move forward to hear you. You must go to them.
- Make eye contact with all who are present.
 - \checkmark Don't focus on only one side of the room.
- $\circ~$ It is okay to use notes, but don't be dependent on them.
 - ✓ Practice.
- Expect interruptions.
 - \checkmark Short of emergency, ignore them.
- Be aware of time, but don't focus on watch or clock.
 - ✓ You MUST abide by host's stated time limit.
 - \checkmark Don't expect to share your total story in time allotted.
 - (Gideons are very good at this.)
- Leave the audience with a challenge.
- Your closing will determine how much content the audience takes with them.
